IT'S A MIRACLE

The term miracle is often misunderstood. Some apply it pretty liberally, for instance, you have heard someone speak of the “miracle of childbirth.” Childbirth is not a miracle. It is beautiful and a blessing, but it is not a miracle. It is totally natural and has been part of God’s natural design for the propagation of all God’s creatures including man. It is wonderful but not miraculous.

A miracle is something that happens beyond human ability. Miracles often suspended or bypassed the natural laws and accomplished something magnificent. In Matthew 8:14-15 Jesus touched the hand of a woman and she was instantly healed of a great fever. The healing was so complete that she got up and started serving Jesus and the disciples straight from her sick bed.

Miracles required a great deal of power. Just imagine what it would take to suspend all the laws of God that He established before the beginning of the earth to govern all things. The power to instantly change 120 gallons of water to wine, to raise the dead with a word, to heal those who were crippled by disease for 30+ years, all the things He was able to accomplish in His three year ministry are evidence of His extreme power over the world.

He also has the power to change you. You can be transformed by His words (Romans 12:2). You can be washed in His blood and made new (Romans 6:1-4). You can be saved from this perverse generation (Acts 2:40). The point of the power of Jesus is not to make physical changes to a physical universe; it is to make spiritual changes to spiritual people so they can live in His spiritual heaven. Let His power change you today.
