The Role of a Preacher

A preacher is a herald, "one who proclaims the message of the King. What is important is that the preacher's message must be that of the King's! "Then Haggai, the Lord's messenger, spoke the Lord's message to the people, saying, "I am with you, says the Lord" (Haggai 1:13). The apostle Paul told Timothy to "preach the word" (2 Tim 4:2), a clear reference to the word of God.

The preacher is an evangelist, literally one who is a "bringer of good tidings." This term has often been misunderstood as some have thought that an evangelist was a travelling preacher. However, Paul encouraged Timothy to stay at Ephesus and "do the work of an evangelist" (2 Tim. 4:5). Titus was sent to Crete to "set in order the things that are lacking, and appoint elders in every city as I commanded you" (Titus 1:5).

Those who would preach the gospel of Christ are to be diligent in their service. They need to study to handle the word of God correctly (2 Tim. 2:15). Paul admonished Timothy, "Till I come, give attention to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine...Meditate on these things; give yourself entirely to them, that your progress may be evident to all... Take heed to yourself and to the doctrine. Continue in them, for in doing this you will save both yourself and those who hear you" (1 Tim. 4:13-16).

As per 1 Tim. 4:16, a preacher must "take heed" to himself. This is similar to the admonition Paul gave the elders at Ephesus (Acts 20:28). It is important that a preacher pays attention to himself and the message he teaches. He needs to work to improve and to be very careful in the message he delivers, as his soul and the souls of others depend upon it.

It is important that the preacher be a good example. Paul told Timothy, "Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity" (1 Tim. 4:12).

Among his works, a preacher is to preach the gospel (2 Tim. 4:2), edify the church (Eph. 4:11-16), appoint elders (Titus 1:5), defend the faith (1 Tim. 1:3; Titus 1:13), and train others (2 Tim. 2:2).

Some might surmise that visitation, calling on members, evangelizing, etc. is his duties, but in reality, it is the duty of all Christians.
