WHAT'S A CHRISTIAN 2 Corinthians 6:17

Diognetius, a second-century Christian, was asked what a Christian was and answered in a letter. His answer was this:

Christians are not differentiated from other people by country, language or customs. They follow local customs in food, clothing and other areas. They marry and have children just like everyone else. But they do not kill unwanted children. They are native to lands but live as aliens and pilgrims there. They love everyone but are persecuted by all. They are put to death and gain life. They are poor yet make many rich. They are dishonored yet gain glory. They are mocked yet bless in return. When they do well they are punished and rejoice. They are attacked as aliens by Jews and persecuted by Greeks. Yet those who hate them cannot give any reason for their hostility.

Paul tells us in 2 Corinthians 6:17, "Come out from among them and be different..." This is a requirement for us if we hope for God to be our Father. Christians are defined by a different set of terms than the world. Meek, gentle, kind, compassionate, loving, humble, all these terms are signs of weakness to the world. To the Christian they are markers of identification. Be characterized as different for the Lord and show the world just what a Christian is.
