A FATHER'S TIME

Ephesians 5:16

James Boswell was one of the great biographers of all time. He wrote 12 works between the years 1762 and 1795. He often referred back to a date in his childhood that was a turning point in his childhood for the better. His dad took him fishing on that day. Someone later checked his dad's journal for that day and there was written, "Took my son fishing today, a day wasted." Time spent with your children is never wasted.

The buzzword for the recent past was "quality time". If you could not take time to be with your kids, just make the short time you have with them quality time, do big things. Paul tells us to "Make the most of our time because the days are evil" (Ephesians 5:16). Evil things are happening in the world and they would love nothing more than to have the time you leave open in your children's lives. Give your family as much time as you possibly can so that you have those teaching opportunities and not the world.

Do not replace popsicles for pop, fishing rods for fishing trips, or presents for presence. Quality time is of no value unless it is in large enough quantity. The truly successful man takes his entire family to heaven with him. If you do not give enough time to study and training with your children you will be more likely to fail in taking your children to heaven.

3. **If you had maintained a pure life** by walking in the light (1 John 1:7-9); not being conformed to the world (Romans 12:1-2); refusing the temptations of the world (Titus 2:11-12).

4. **If you had died "in the Lord"** (Revelation 14:13; Psalms 116:15).
