YOU ARE SO BEAUTIFUL

I heard a story about a little boy whose mother had just had a baby. She took the baby and her boy to the beauty shop to show off her newest child. Everyone gathered about the baby to “ooh” and “ahh” over it. While they were gathered around, the young boy asked for some money to buy a drink. His mother said, “Now, you know what to say when you ask for something like that.” The boy replied, “Mommy, you are so thin and beautiful.” The boy promptly received the money for the drink.

Understand that being beautiful is not wrong, but being consumed with it so that all else is abandoned becomes wrong. Peter writes in 1 Peter 3:1-4, “In the same way, wives be submissive to your own husbands so that even if they are disobedient to the word, they may be won without a word by the behavior of their wives, as they observe your chaste and respectful behavior. Your adornment must not be merely external braiding of the hair, and wearing of gold jewelry, or putting on dresses; but let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the imperishable quality of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is precious in the sight of God.”

Peter does not say, “Don’t put on dresses.” He says do not let the dress be the focus of the person. Let the beauty come from the inside out. If you are only concerned about the outside appearance, than the inside will remain ugly. If you work from the inside out, then the person will be beautiful beyond description. (Philippians 3:18-21).
