DON'T BE ASHAMED

1 Timothy 1:8

Paul tells Timothy in 1 Timothy 1:8, "Therefore do not be ashamed of the testimony of our Lord Jesus Christ or of me his prisoner." He also says that when we study we should do so that we can prove we are workers unashamed of the gospel. The Greek word for shame deals with having shame for something you have done. One natural indication from this is that we have to be doing something to feel shame for it. In using such language it is assumed that action is being taken by the reader. Paul knew that Timothy was doing the work of an evangelist and told him not to be ashamed of that work. We, too, must be doing the work if we would be known for it; then we should not be ashamed of that reputation.

Another implication from this verse is to be careful what you do so that your actions do not bring you shame. Paul tells Timothy in 1 Timothy 4:16 to take heed or pay close attention to himself. Make sure you are doing what you should do, and not doing what you should not do. In fact, Jesus warns his closest disciples 16 times in the gospels to take heed to themselves and to what they heard and did. Avoid such activities that would cause shame to come to you. Stay clear of the appearances of evil. Keep your outside as clean as you want the inside to be. Take heed to yourself lest you too fall.

Do not be ashamed of Christianity. It is the marker of someone who will live in glory forever. Do not hide it so that no one sees it. Do not be ashamed of the actions you take in public. Do not act in such a way as to embarrass you or the church. Behave in a Christian manner. Don't be ashamed.
