THREE SETS OF EYES

Psychologists say there are three perceptions of people. Who others think you are, who you think you are, and who you really are. There is actually some truth to that if you think about it.

First consider that other people do look at you. They develop an opinion of you based on what they see. This opinion will not be complete because they do not know the motivation for your actions so they have to assume those. Also, they look through the prism of their own personal experiences and see things their way in your life. Therefore, they cannot see the whole picture, only enough to develop their own opinion.

You see things from your point of view. This point of view is often changing. As you mature, have other experiences, and learn more things, you change how you view life. This opinion matters more because 1 John 3:20 says that if our hearts convict us we have sinned. But our own perception can also be skewed as Paul was when he persecuted the church with clear conscience. We must shift the prism with which we view our lives to match what is proper, the Bible.

Jesus sees things as they are. He made the prism, the Bible is His word and the judge of all men (John 12:48). And He created you which means He knows what you do and why you do it. He is the one who makes the final determination if you will go to heaven or will be left out. And He can see properly to make that determination.

You will please one of these sets of eyes. Which will it be? The ones of others who will never be pleased? Your own eyes which can deceive? Or the eyes of Jesus who see all things and can reward you for obedience?
