Ephesians 5:19

Tonight we have an awesome opportunity. The elders in their wisdom have chosen to have a singing emphasis service each time a month has five Sundays. This happens to be the fifth Sunday in January so this evening we will sing joyously together praise to the Lord. It is a wonderful opportunity to learn new songs, hear leaders who do not always get opportunity, and to worship God in our singing efforts.

Because the words my heart raise are an effort to glorify my King. And He loves to hear that.

You do not have a bad voice if you use what God gave you. Your heart sings beautifully when you mean the praise you bring in each song. Join us tonight as we meet to honor God with our lips in praise of song won't you?
